

Wealthy, well-born, violently courageous, at times calmly meditative, scholarly, and deeply religious, Scipio Africanus Major believed himself close to the gods and is said to have walked through life as though he were in a dream. At the age of inneteen, already a veteran military officer, he raillied the dispirited remnants of the Roman army following the disastrous battle of Cannae in 216 B.C., thirteen years later, as a consul, he defeated the great Hannibal at the North African town of Zama uniferent years aiter, as a cousta, in correctance, the great realmining at the Yorth Arthou town to Jamas intellect to such an extent that his conservative political opponents called him more Greek than Roman; and although these same opponents were to finally bring about his downfall in Rome, the accomplishments of this brilliant soldier and statesman would remain an inspiration throughout the centuries of Roman history that were yet to come.



The personality of Tokugawa Iyeyasu looms large in Japanese history, casting a shadow that covers centuries. The founder of one of the longest and most powerful dynasties the world has ever seen, arguably the greatest field commander and government administrator in Japanese history — for a naturally cautious and circumspect man, Iyeyasu's impact on the evolution of modern Japan is tremendous and amazing. The rule of the Tokugawa shogunate effectively began in the year 1600 when the factions opposed to lyeyasu were crushed in the battle of Sekigahara; it would continue, in a reign of almost unbroken isolation and peace, for a period of more than two and a half centuries. Iyeyasu and his successors practically eliminated all contact with the European nations during this time, a policy of national seclusion that was to have far-reaching consequences - and in this way as well as many others, "Tokugawa Japan" gave shape to the Japan of today.

Bartolomeo Colleoni had a shrewd eye for his own immortality when he asked for a statue of himself to be put up in Venice. Although the laws of the Serene Republic denied him the site he would have preferred, in St. Mark's Square, enough tourists seek out Verrocchio's masterpiece in the quieter setting of San Giovanni e Paolo to make sure that the condottiere's name and features are still known throughout the world.

A complicated man born into a complicated time, Collooni used his imagination, determination and sheer foughness to battle his way to the top of the 15th century Italian world. By the time Colleoni retired from a mercenary career spent largely in the service of Venice, his fame and reputation had spread far beyond the borders of Italy.

It was partly due to his status as a popular hero in the eyes of the ever-vocal British public that Charles George "Chinese" Gordon — soldier, adventuera agent 10 British imperialism— was sent to the Sudan in 1884. His instructions upon arrival in Khartoum were vague; he was to voresee the evacuation of British and Egyptian troops in the lace of the successful rebellion of the Mahdi, and at the same time, he was to leave behind him an organized government in Khartoum, Hardly the docale usbordinate by nature, Gordon made few moves to follow these guidelines, instead proceeding to proclaim the Sudan's independence, demand Turkish troops to assist him in his fight against the Mahdi, and request the presence of Zobeir Pasha, a notorious slave dealer, to form an alternative leadership to the renegade, self-proclaimed Moslem messiah. Gordon's forceful personality continued to have an influence even after he himself was beheaded by the Mahdi's Ansar tribesman on January 26, 1885; his death caused a popular outery in England and contributed strongly to the collapse of Gladston's Elberal government that year.
